Coordinator of Multigenerational Ministries - St. Luke Lutheran Church, Albuquerque, N.M.

St Luke Lutheran Church seeks an approximately three-quarter time Coordinator of Multigenerational Ministries (CMGM) to support St. Luke Lutheran Church in carrying out its mission of being “**Rooted in God’s Word, serving in God’s world**” and its vision of being “**an inviting and thriving multi-generational Congregation and Preschool**” through leading and coordinating church multigenerational programs and occasional new initiatives, with an emphasis on accompanying and equipping the whole St. Luke Church community, and especially parents, grandparents and godparents in raising children in all aspects of Christian worship, community, education, and loving service. The St. Luke CMGM encourages growing and varied ministry participation; helps provide safe, attractive “entry points” into the community for new and diverse families; demonstrates a commitment to excellence; and fosters a spirit of holy experimentation and listening hearts.

St. Luke currently offers or is *in planning** for the following Multigenerational ministries:

- “Welcome to God’s Family” and “Splash” baptism gifts, cards & outreach
- *Baby Frolic Group** (for parents and families with children ages newborn-three)
- Sunday School Godly Play for younger children and Spark for older elementary
- *Confirmation Group** (6th grade and up – primarily led by pastors)
- 5-6 “Faith Stepping Stones” multigenerational workshops per year (Backpack Blessing Sunday, Bible Sunday [Reformation Day], Baptism Celebration [All Saints Sunday], *Advent Fair**, Lenten Fair, and Holy Communion workshops, etc.)
- Salt & Spark Multigenerational Choir (run by the Coordinator of Music Ministries)
- We are the “anchor church” for an Albuquerque-wide “Love God Love Neighbor” monthly service event for youth 6th grade and up with their parents/grandparents/ or other adult leaders
- Multigenerational participation (readers, acolytes, crucifers, *greeters**, *sacristy care**) in our worship services, including an informal service on Saturday evenings and two liturgical services on Sunday morning, plus seasonal Wednesday night soup suppers and services such as Advent and Lent
- Staffed nursery at all weekend services
- Annual Rainbow Trail Vacation Bible Camp on campus, and scholarships to help send Middle and High school students to Rainbow Trail onsite camp in Colorado

The successful candidate will:

- Be committed in Christian faith and Church ministry
- have some familiarity with Lutheran theological and sacramental tradition
- hold a Bachelor’s Degree (or higher) in a related field, or equivalent training/experience.
- Have a strong interest in life-long Christian Education and related resources
- Have strong organizational, time management and administrative skills
- Demonstrated interpersonal and communication skills

We would love to have a person who would joyfully expand the multigenerational community, worship, and service outreach of our congregation!

Specific duties include:

- Collaborate with pastors, other staff, and an enthusiastic Children, Youth & Family Ministry Team in multigenerational curricula selection, program and event planning, communication, and implementation
- Prepare and support volunteer teachers and other volunteer staff
- Supervise and coordinate paid nursery staff
- Plan and track a CYF budget throughout the year
- Seek out opportunities for small groups from St. Luke to participate in Multigenerational Ministry workshops, denominational and ecumenical community and continuing education events

Time & Compensation:

Part-time salaried; 25-30 hours per week (varying with season); approximately mid 30K, commensurate with skill and experience. Some of the preparation and communication work may be done remotely, in-person presence expected for in-person ministry programs.
